Background

The Center of Innovation and Entrepreneurship in the Stillman School of Business is administering an endowed scholarship to assist Stillman School students who have financial need and who are interested in entrepreneurship. The scholarships are funded through an endowment created by Seton Hall University alumnus David B. Gerstein, Class of '63.

Eligible students can compete for a one-time scholarship that will range in amounts from \$3,000 to \$3,500. Seven scholarships will be awarded.

Basic Eligibility

- 1. All students who are regularly admitted undergraduate students of the Stillman School of Business are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The other eligibility requirements are as follows: The applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- The applicant must have a cumulative minimum grade point average of 3.0. The applicant must be in good standing at the University.
- The applicant must be earning a Certificate in Entrepreneurship, or be enrolled in the Entrepreneurship Concentration, or otherwise demonstrate a strong interest in entrepreneurship.

Essay Requirement

The applicant must submit an original essay that addresses the following points: • Why do you want to become an entrepreneur and secure a business degree? • How have the challenges you have faced in life spurred your interest to become an entrepreneur? The submission should consist of a maximum of five, typed, double-spaced pages.
