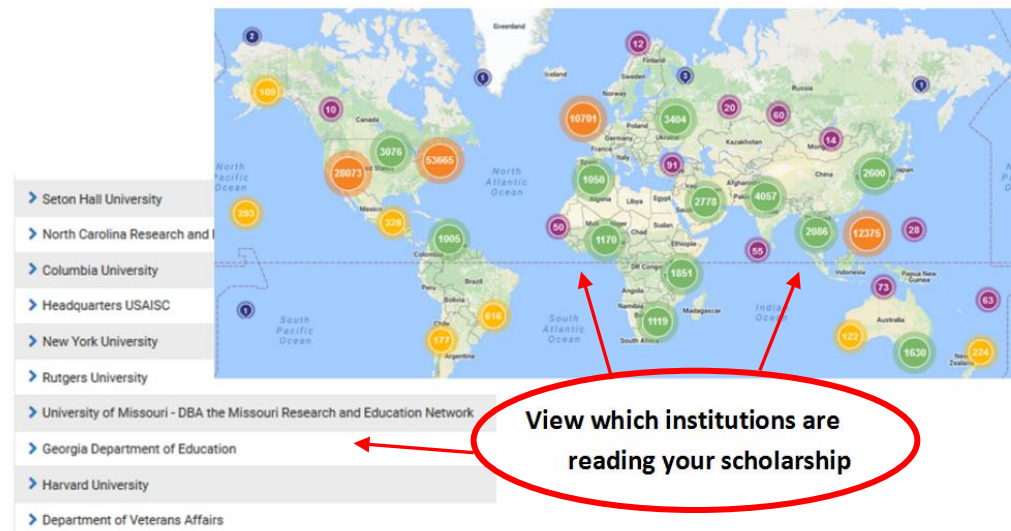

eRepository is a service offered by the University Libraries, Seton Hall University and Seton Hall Law School. Available to faculty and graduate students, the goal of the repository is to preserve and disseminate scholarly works.

Important facts:

- Almost 2 million downloads occurred worldwide (as of May 2017).
- View global readership by publication, institution, country and sector
- Useful for the rank and tenure statistics
- Available to all departments for publications, journals and conference proceedings
- Review SHU theses and dissertations



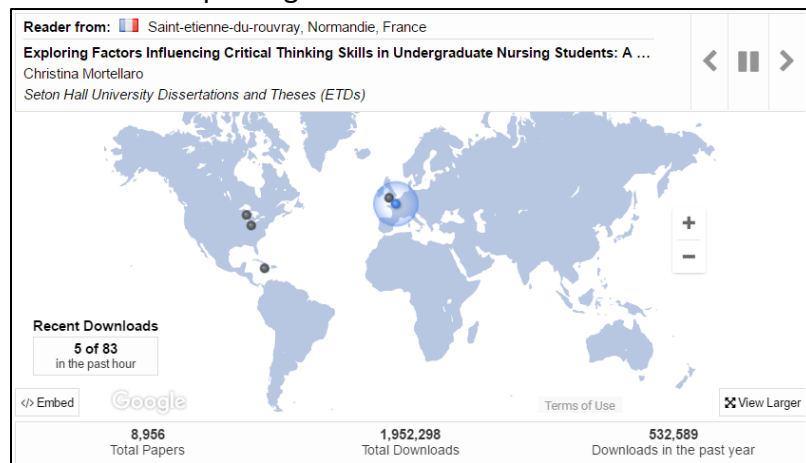
Setting up a faculty profile

- Over 100 SHU faculty have created profiles
- Set up your profile here: <https://works.bepress.com/account/register/>
- **Might have a profile?** Google “bepress + your name” and your profile will appear at the top of the search results
- Manage your profile by posting scholarship and media appearances
- Pull statistics for the Rank & Tenure process
- View where your scholarship is being read globally
- Graduate assistants can create accounts and update faculty profile

Copyright:

- Checking copyright is important; University Libraries will do this for you.
- Save pre-print copies of your publications, we can generally post these for download.
