Look at and talk about the objects together. What stereotypes do you notice?

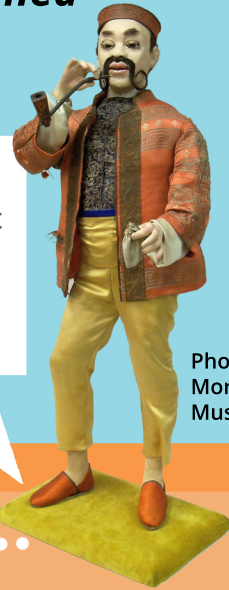

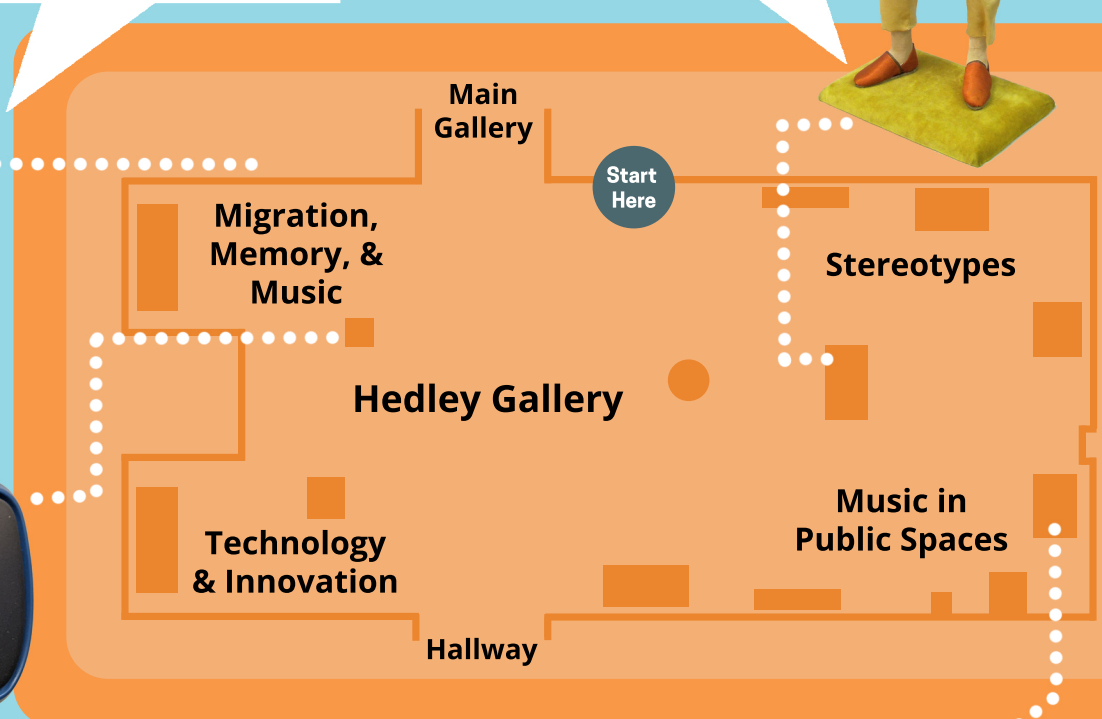
