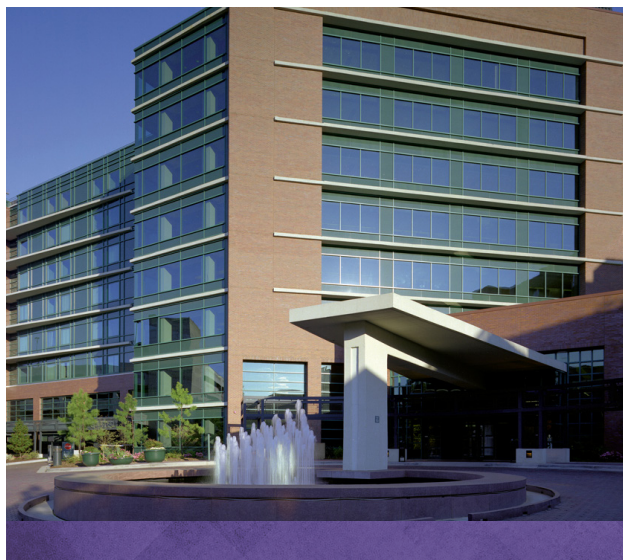


Spartanburg Regional Healthcare System Fact Sheet

- Spartanburg Medical Center (SMC), a 540-bed research and teaching hospital

- Spartanburg Hospital for Restorative Care (SHRC), a 97-bed long-term, acute-care hospital with a 25-bed skilled nursing facility
- Pelham Medical Center, a 48-bed, acute-care facility, includes an emergency center, medical office building and numerous practices and amenities
- Spartanburg Regional Hospice includes in-home hospice services and a 15-bed Hospice Home providing comfort, care and support services to patients with a life-limiting illness
- Medical Group of the Carolinas (MGC), physician offices located throughout our seven-county service area
- Regional HealthPlus (RHP), a network of hospitals and physicians of every specialty
- Spartanburg Regional Foundation has returned more than \$30 million to the community to support health and wellness
