

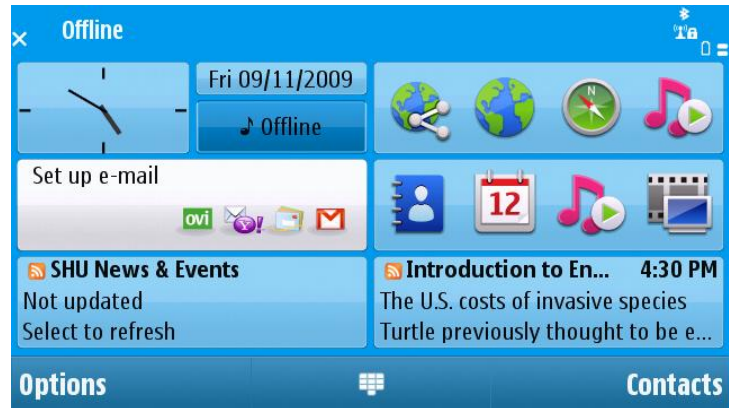


## Nokia N-97 :: Student email setup

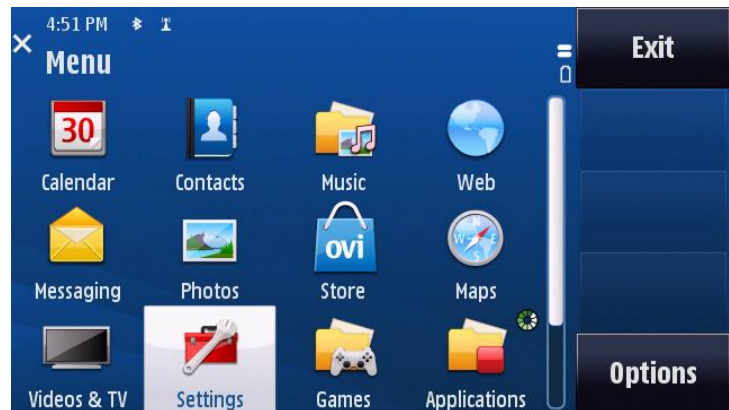
In order to setup your SHU email, you must first connect to the Seton Hall Wireless network via the procedure outlined below.

### Nokia N-97 :: On-Campus Internet Connection

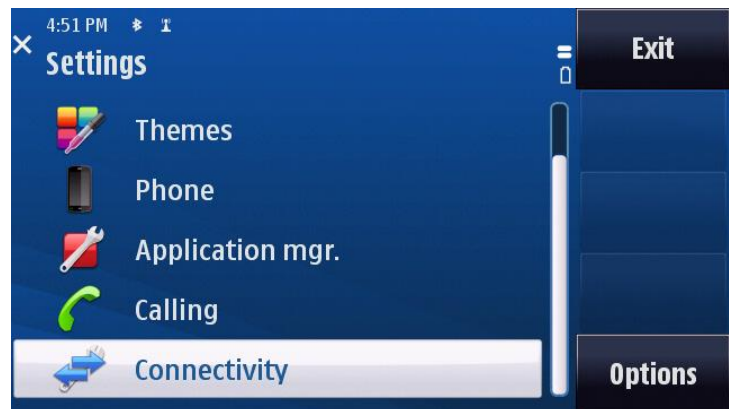
1. Start at the Home Screen.



2. Press the Silver Menu button, then select **Settings**

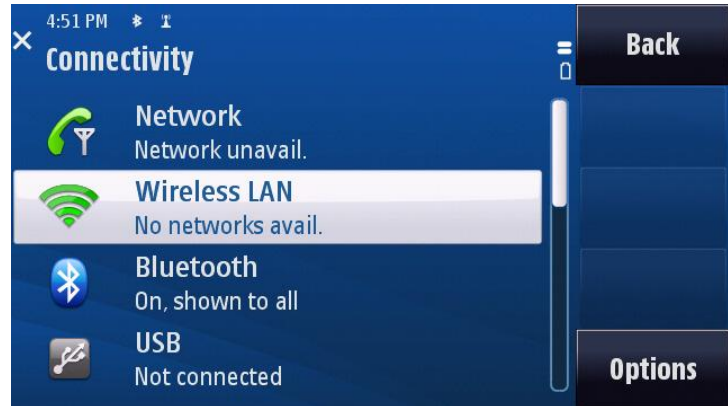


3. Scroll down and select **Connectivity**

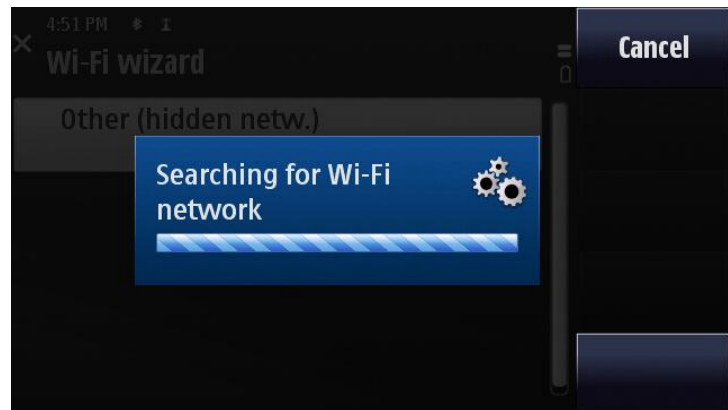




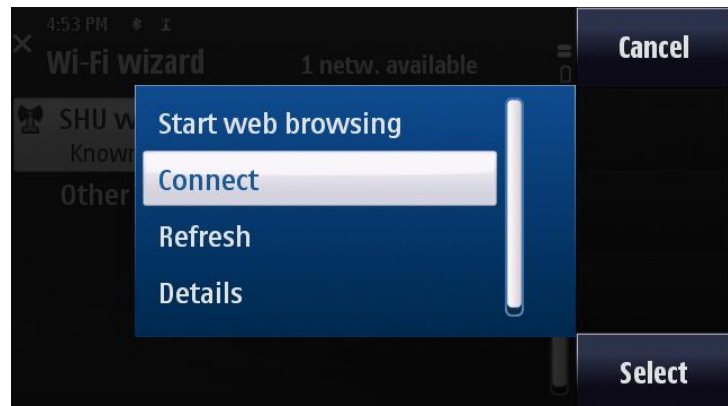
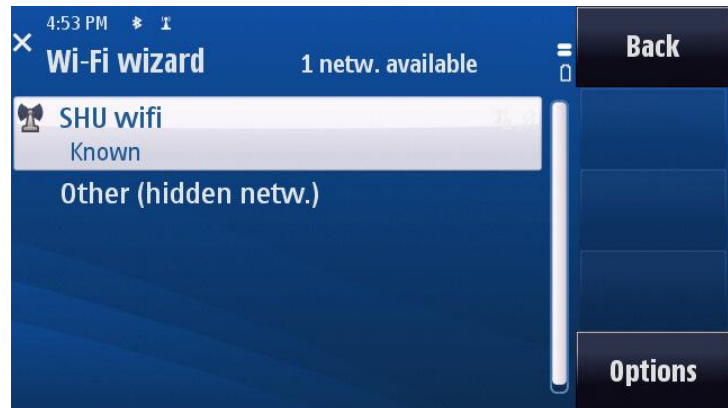
4. Scroll down and select **Wireless LAN**



5. Select **SHU wifi**



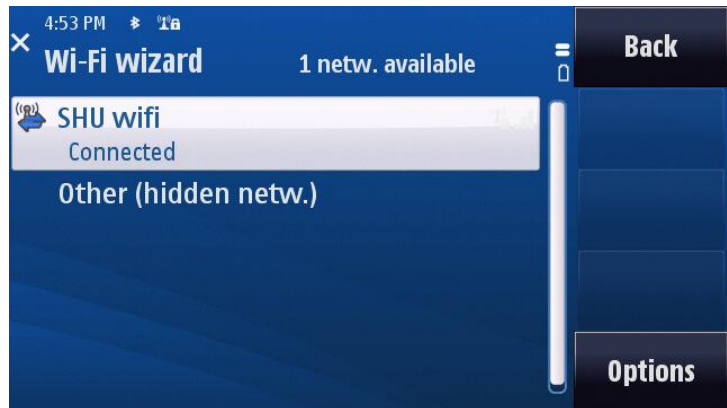
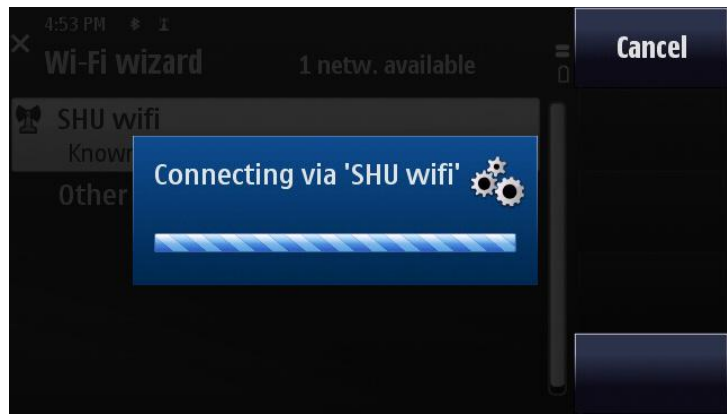
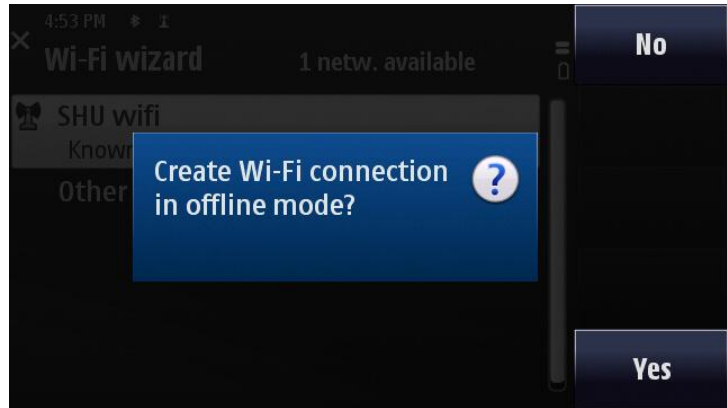
6. Select **Connect**





- 7. When prompted to Create Wi-Fi connection in offline mode? Select **Yes**

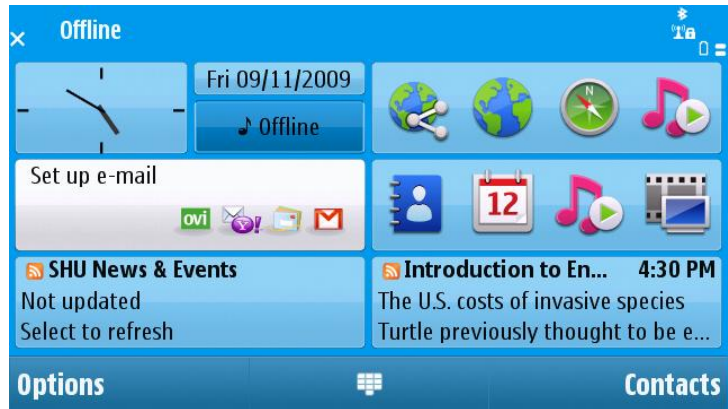
Offline mode refers to the device not having a SIM card.

1. From the home screen Select **Set up e-mail**



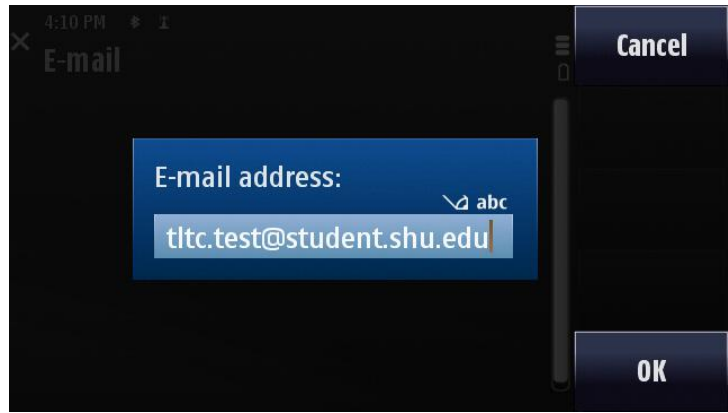
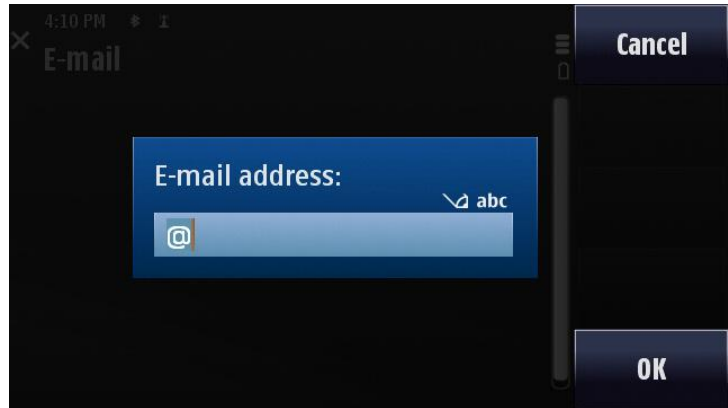
2. Select **Start**





- 3. When prompted, enter your email address

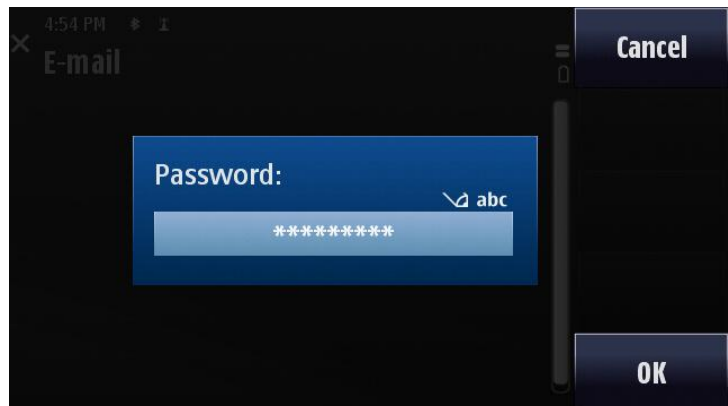
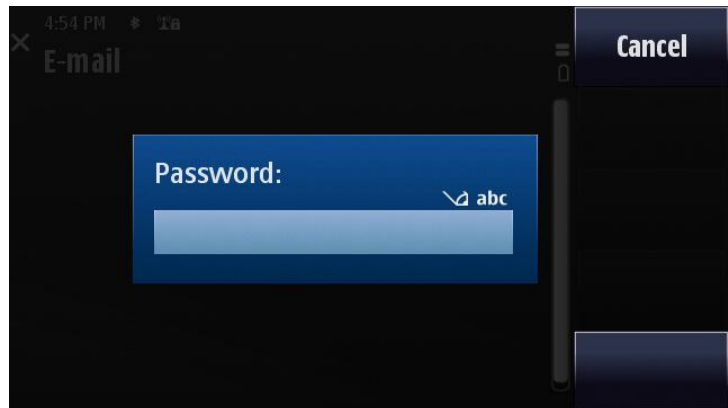

- 4. Enter your password

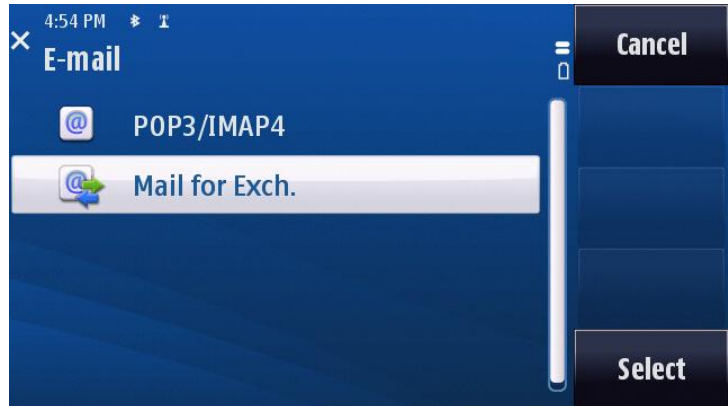

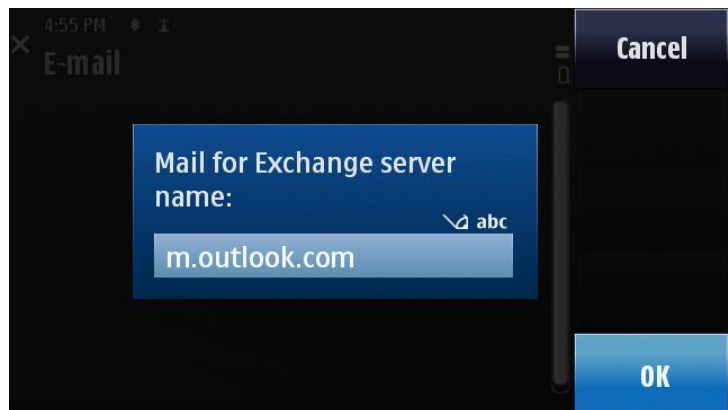
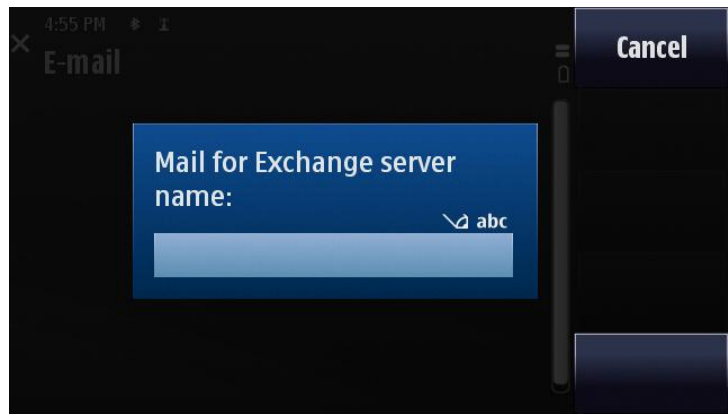
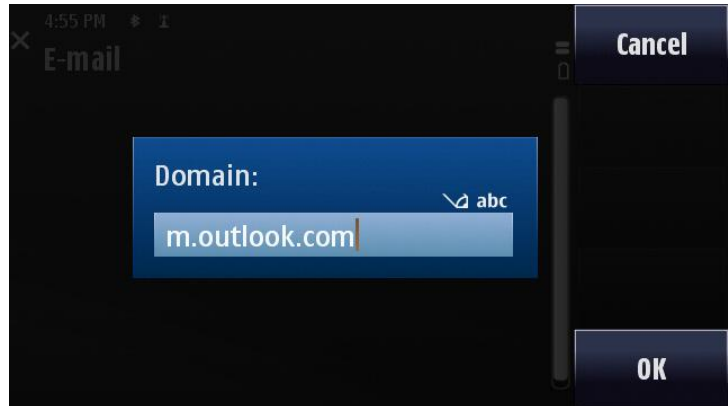


7. Enter the Domain:  
**m.outlook.com**





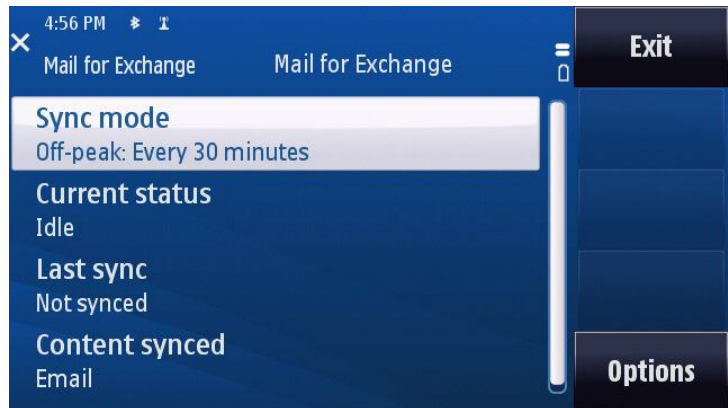
8. In the Exchange Server field, enter **m.outlook.com**



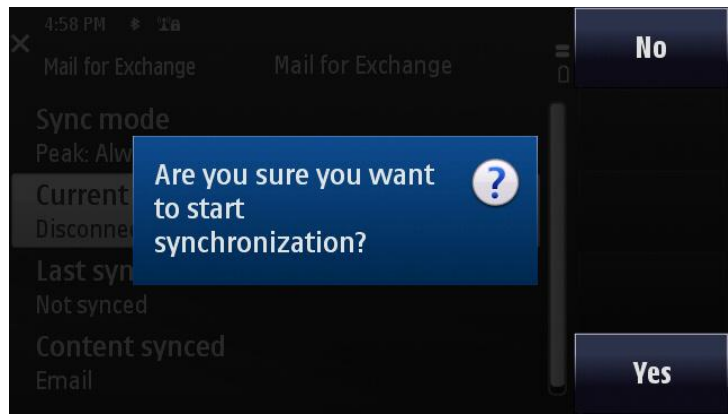




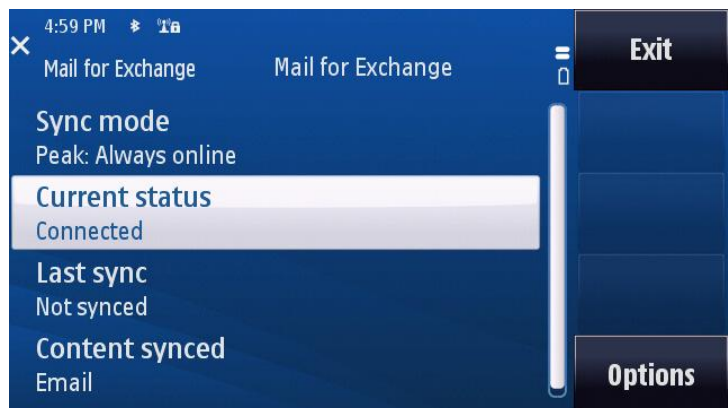
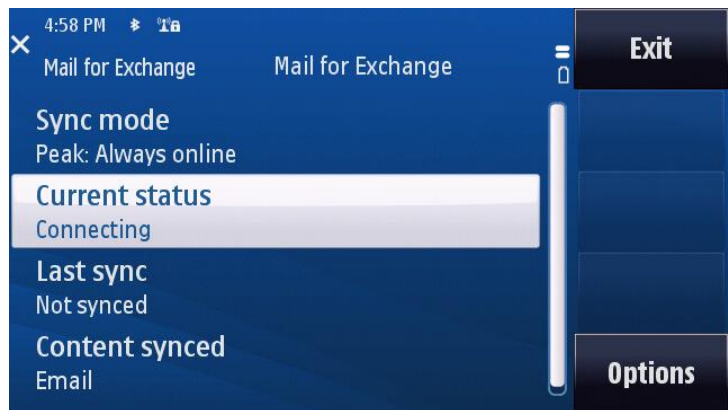
9. The next screen shows that the Current Status is Idle



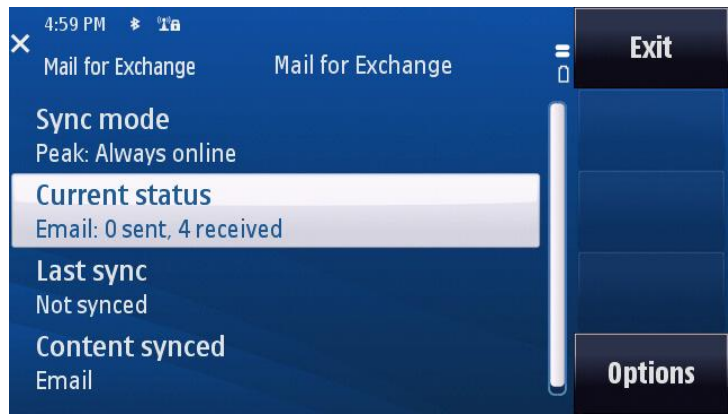
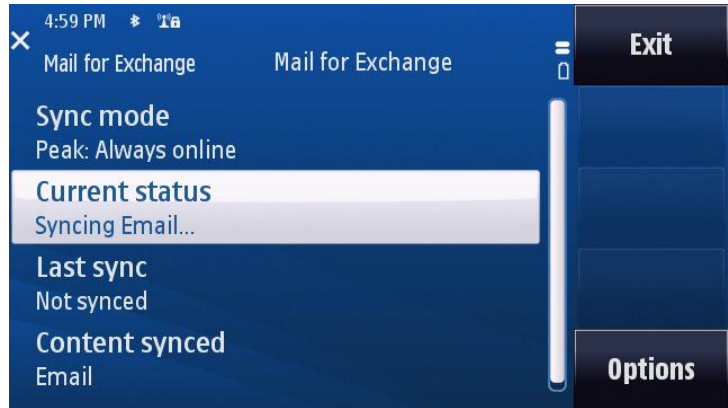
10. Scroll down and select the Current Status to start synchronization
