Jonathan Larsen is the Special Agent in Charge of the Newark Field Office and has held this position since March of 2015. Mr. Larsen is responsible for the strategic planning, development, coordination and implementation of programs within the Newark Field Office that ensure the delivery of IRS criminal investigative programs within New Jersey. This includes tax enforcement, money laundering investigations, narcotics and terrorism, and the bank secrecy act.

Criminal Investigation's (CI) mission is to serve the American public by investigating potential criminal violations of the Internal Revenue Code and related financial crimes in a manner that fosters confidence in the tax system and compliance with the law. CI's law enforcement priorities are the investigation of income tax evasion and other financial crimes. This encompasses fraud in legal and illegal industries, and narcotics related financial crimes as well as terrorism financing. CI investigates and assists in the prosecution of significant financial crimes that generate the maximum deterrent effect, enhance voluntary compliance and promote public confidence in the tax system.

Mr. Larsen began his career in law enforcement as a police officer and detective in New Jersey in 1993. He became a Special Agent with CI in 2000 in Warwick, Rhode Island. He served as a Supervisory Special Agent in Bridgeport, CT and a Senior Analyst with International Operations in Washington, DC prior to his promotion to the Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the Newark Field Office. He has a Bachelor of Science degree in Administration of Justice from Rutgers College.
