

Fred Schindler is the Director of Headquarters Collection in the IRS Small Business/Self-Employed Division. He began his IRS career in 1998 in the Office of Chief Counsel in Washington, DC, where he worked in the General Litigation and Procedure and Administration Divisions. From 2005 to 2006 he served as Deputy Assistant Chief Counsel for Collection, Bankruptcy and Summonses. In 2006, Fred moved into the IRS Collection operation as Director, Collection Policy, a position he held through 2010. During 2009, Fred also served as the IRS Bureau Accountable Official for implementation and reporting of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. From 2010 to 2013, he led the IRS implementation of the Non-Exchange provisions of the Affordable Care Act, before returning to the Office of Chief Counsel to serve as Deputy Associate Chief Counsel in Procedure and Administration. Fred became the Director of the IRS Offer in Compromise and Lien programs in early 2017 and held that position until taking his current assignment.
