The Office of the Provost is in receipt of the resolution regarding the Dean of the School of Diplomacy approved at the Faculty Senate's September 10 meeting. We agree that inaction of appointing a permanent dean will harm efforts of the school to attain its strategic goals and that the Faculty Guide requires a search and screen committee for dean-level searches. We appreciate that the faculty participates in the selection process for administrators with responsibility in the academic area, and we appreciate that the faculty supports a search for the next Dean of the School of Diplomacy and International Relations, subject to the procedures outlined in Article 13 of the Faculty Guide, starting January 1. Accordingly, we will forward a charge for a search and screen committee soon.
