

APC Report: December 17, 2021

At its November 11 meeting, APC discussed and approved a recommendation regarding a small change to the requirements for the Deans List, namely, to modify a restriction that a student cannot have withdrawn from a class to be eligible. APC now brings the following proposed resolution regarding that recommendation before the Senate:

Draft Senate Resolution:

Whereas the current qualifications for the Deans List includes a restriction that a student cannot be eligible if they have withdrawn from a class during the relevant semester;

Whereas that restriction appears to be unduly restrictive, disqualifying students who may be compelled to withdraw for a variety of legitimate reasons;

Resolved: the Dean's List requirement disqualifying students who have withdrawn from a class during the semester should be replaced with the provision that students who withdraw from a class during the relevant semester remain eligible for the Dean's List unless they previously have withdrawn from two classes while enrolled at Seton Hall.

APC's subcommittee on revising the university's student evaluation form has held an organizational meeting, electing King Mott and Amy Hunter co-chairs. The subcommittee is doing some background reading and will get down to business in earnest next semester.
