Overview The College of Arts and Sciences of Seton Hall University, in its continued initiative to support undergraduate research in all disciplines, publishes the journal *Locus* to celebrate undergraduate students' scholarly work. Now in its seventh volume, this annual publication is a collaborative effort from student editors and contributors, along with support from faculty advisors, across three principal academic areas.

New call for submissions We invite longer scholarly works (5-9K words) written by undergraduate students at Seton Hall University; we also accept alumni work completed up to **two years prior to the Fall 2026** publication date. We encourage a writing style that, while erudite and conversant with the author's specific area of research, is also accessible to non-specialists. Manuscripts will be peer reviewed by undergraduate student editors of the College of Arts and Sciences who represent the humanities, sciences and mathematics, and social sciences. While the journal is housed in the College of Art and Sciences, contributions from student authors from all Seton Hall colleges and academic units are welcome. **The deadline for submitting a paper for Volume 9 is 31 May 2026.**
